Preaching June 25: Pastor Guy Marquardt

Pastor Guy Marquardt and his wife Linda both grew up in Appleton, Wisconsin, and were married in 1990. After Guy's graduation from Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary in 1994, he was assigned to work as a missionary in



Brazil. He served there for fourteen years; church planting and training national pastors.

The Marquardt family moved to Lodi, California, in 2009 where Guy pastored Christ Ev. Lutheran Church. Then in late 2015, he accepted the call to serve as WELS Friendly Counselor to India. Guy and Linda have four children: David, Holly, Sara, and Jonathan.

Christ Evangelical Lutheran Ministries (CELM), the WELS daughter church in India, serves over 5,500 souls in 120 congregations in southeastern India. WELS counselors help train Indians to carry the good news of Jesus Christ to their own people. More than 50 have graduated from this 7-year program and now serve in congregations. Another 20 men are studying in the program as they serve congregations on a part-time basis. WELS also supports a translation and publications program which provides Christian literature in both the Telugu and Hindi languages.

The WELS budget does not fund all the needs of the CELM.

Gifts to the WELS India Project Fund support:

- Construction of chapels,
- Computers and internet access for seminary graduates,
- Purchase of bicycles for gospel workers,
- Extraordinary medical needs for CELM members, and
- Translation and publication of Christian material in Telugu and Hindi
